



The RMs Summer Idea Camp is a 3-day course for future managers in the fields of management, sustainable development, efficient use of resources and the circular economy. By completing this course students will be able to complement their academic profile and professional competences by gaining practical management skills highly demanded by the labour market and all innovation professionals in the field of raw materials and natural resources management.

A total of 22,5 hours of lectures combining interactive case-based presentations, practical exercises and solution-focused team work activities have been devised in the programme curriculum. The course is **free of charge** and open to Bachelor, Master and PhD students. It is a hybrid course that combines face-to-face classroom instruction with online learning. All lectures will be given in English.

The RMs Summer Idea Camp is part of the activities of the EIT RMsManager Project, funded by the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT Raw Materials).

A **Certificate of Completion** labelled by the EIT Raw Materials will be conceded to all students after completing the course. In order to get the certificate of completion, students are required to complete at least 80% of the total number of lecture hours.
